


LAUNDRY ROOM DO'S AND DON'TS



DO: DROP LAUNDRY PODS IN THE DRUM, NOT THE DETERGENT DRAWER

Laundry pods are made for direct placement into the washer's drum. Otherwise, the degradable wrap doesn't fully dissolve and can clog the detergent drawer that others need to use.



DON'T: ASSUME A BROKEN MACHINE HAS BEEN REPORTED

Putting an "out of order" sign on a machine is great, but don't stop there. CSC wants to make sure you have access to machines that work, and we won't know of an issue unless it's reported. It's quick and easy to submit a service request directly from your laundry app by noting the location and the machine's license plate number. The sooner we know of an issue, the sooner we can get it fixed.



DON'T: BE A BAD LAUNDRY CITIZEN

Just as you do, everyone else likes arriving at a clean, ready-to-use laundry room, too. Clean out the lint trap, throw away any trash, wipe down the washer if needed — do whatever is needed to leave the laundry room the way you'd like to find it on your next visit.



DO: REMOVE YOUR LAUNDRY QUICKLY

Emptying machines quickly helps everyone. It helps others get their laundry started, and it helps you avoid having your laundry handled by others. Your laundry app alerts you when your laundry is done so that you can remove it before others do.
